This memo is for the information of the Lord Mayor and Councillors.

### Background

At the meeting of the Resilient Communities Committee on 13 February 2023, further information was sought on the change of legal entity of an Accommodation Grant recipient for the lessee at 19 Greenknowe Avenue, Potts Point from the Sydney Children's Hospital Network (ABN 53 188 579 090) to South Eastern Sydney Local Health District (SESLHD) (ABN 70 442 041 439).

Staff have confirmed that both entities are government agencies within NSW Health. Council approval is required due to the change in the ABN of the grant recipient.

The City receives a range of grant applications from government departments and agencies, such as local schools seeking venue hire support and government departments and agencies wishing to partner with the City to deliver significant festivals and events.

When funding government departments and agencies City staff ensure that only projects which deliver significant benefit to local communities and business are recommended to Council for grant funding.
