#### Road Works – Temporary Road Closure – Wilson Street, Newtown

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the following temporary road closures in Newtown:

- Wilson Street, between Bucknell Street and Brocks Lane, from Saturday 31 August 2019 to Monday 23 September 2019;
- Westbound travel lanes in Wilson Street, between Burren and Queen Streets, from Thursday 1 August 2019 to Friday 7 February 2020; and
- Eastbound travel lanes in Wilson Street, between Queen and Golden Grove Streets, from Thursday 1 August 2019 to Friday 7 February 2020.
- Subject to the following conditions:
  - (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as mentioned in Schedule B of this agenda.
  - (B) The Applicant must comply with any other conditions imposed by City's Construction Regulation Unit.
  - (C) The Applicant has indicated Monday 2 September 2019 to Tuesday 8 October 2019 as contingency dates for the closure of Wilson Street, between Bucknell Street and Brocks Lane.
  - (D) The Applicant has indicated Thursday 15 August 2019 to Friday 6 March 2019 as contingency dates for the one-way closures of Wilson Street, between Burren Street and Golden Grove Streets.

- (E) The Applicant must contact the Newtown PAC to discuss deployment of user pay police for the road closure.
- (F) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed closure and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.
