Recommendation

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the western side of George Street, Sydney, between the points 28 metres and 48 metres (three car spaces), south of Rawson Place as "Loading Zone Ticket 10am-6pm Mon-Fri", "4P Ticket 8pm-12am Mon-Fri 8am-10pm Sat, Sun and Public Holidays" and "No Stopping Other Times".

Decision

The Committee carried the recommendation unanimously and the Committee noted the following:

“As part of a CTMP for Light Rail works on Rawson Street it is required that No Parking be installed on the western side of George Street between Valentine Street & Rawson Street. Once the CTMP period has ended the proposed parking and loading zone changes on George Street will be installed. City of Sydney will be notified prior to the parking changes will be installed.”
