It is recommended that the Committee endorse the reallocation of parking on the eastern side of Castlereagh Street, Sydney, between the points 91 metres and 124 metres (six car spaces), south of King Street, and between the points 96 metres and 114 metres (three car spaces), south of Liverpool Street, as "Bus Lane 6am-8pm Mon-Fri 10am-6pm Sat, Sun and Public Holidays" and "No Parking Other Times".
