Traffic Treatment - Raised Marked Pedestrian Crossing and Continuous Footpath Treatment - Buckland and Phillips Streets, Alexandria

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the following traffic treatments at the intersection of Buckland and Phillips Streets, Alexandria:

- (A) Install a raised marked cycle and pedestrian crossing in Buckland Street, just west of Phillips Street;
- (B) Installation of a continuous footpath treatment (CFT) in Phillips Street, just north of Buckland Street; and
- (C) Removal of the existing raised threshold and median island in Phillips Street, north of Buckland Street.
