#### **Traffic Treatment - Shared Zone - John Street, St James Avenue and Woolley Lane, Glebe**

##### Recommendation

It is recommended that the Committee support the installation of a Shared Zone in John Street, St James Avenue and Woolley Lane, Glebe.

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the following:

- (A) Continuous footpath treatment in John Street at the intersections with Clare and Woolley Streets;
- (B) Continuous footpath treatment in St James Avenue at the intersection with Hereford Street;
- (C) Continuous footpath treatment in Woolley Lane at the intersection with Woolley Street; and
- (D) Raised thresholds in John Street and St James Avenue.
