### Traffic Treatment - Pedestrian Refuge - Maddox Street, Alexandria

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the installation of a pedestrian refuge in Maddox Street, Alexandria, at Mitchell Road. As part of the proposal, the following parking changes are required:

- (A) On the northern side, between the points 9.9 and 16.8 metres (one car space) east of Mitchell Road as "No Stopping".
- (B) On the southern side, between the points 10.5 and 15.2 metres (one car space) east of Mitchell Road as "No Stopping".
