Traffic Treatment – Proposed Pedestrian Crossing – Bay Street, Ultimo

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the installation of the following traffic treatments in Bay Street, Ultimo:

- (A) A marked pedestrian crossing in Bay Street between Queen and Crown Streets;
- (B) Two speed cushions one on each approach to the proposed pedestrian crossing; and
- (C) Kerb islands on both sides of Bay Street between Queen and Crown Streets.
