

Item 13.7**Notices of Motion****Queen Elizabeth II Monument**

It is resolved that:

- (A) Council note:
 - (i) public monuments, memorials and artworks play an important part of the historical and civic record of Australia's public institutions and constitutional history;
 - (ii) Queen Elizabeth II served as Australia's Head of State for over 70 years and was the longest-reigning sovereign in Australia's history; and
 - (iii) there is currently no monument within the City of Sydney local government area that documents her service as part of that civic and historical record;
- (B) Council further note that the public record of Australia's Heads of State should be complete and accurately reflected within the City of Sydney's civic and public spaces; and
- (C) the Lord Mayor be requested to write to the Premier seeking an update on the consideration of a monument, memorial or artwork documenting Queen Elizabeth II's service as Australia's Head of State within the Macquarie Street East Master Plan.

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
