I disclose that I am a former employee of Cox Architecture, the architect of this item.

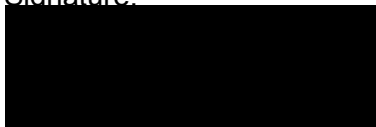
