Background

On 20 September 2017, the Committee endorsed a part-time “No Stopping” restriction to provide vehicular access to the Sydney Metro Pitt Street North site.

The development has received approval to carry out works 24 hours a day and have requested for to extend the part-time “No Stopping” restriction to full-time.

Comments

The kerb space on the eastern side of Pitt Street, where the parking change is proposed, is currently signposted as “No Stopping 7am-6pm Mon-Fri 7am-1pm Sat” and “4P Ticket 6pm-10pm Mon-Fri 1pm-10pm Sat 8am-10pm Sun & Public Holidays”.

Following approval to allow construction works to be carried out 24 hours a day, on-site inspection show that it would be suitable to provide a full-time No Stopping restriction in order to provide vehicular access.

Consultation

The proposal has not been consulted since it is already illegal for drivers to obstruct access to a driveway. The installation of the No Stopping sign reinforces the Road Rules.

Financial

All costs associated with the parking change will be borne by the Applicant.
