Background

Vigilant Group has requested the temporary installation of a “No Parking 8.30am-8.30pm” restriction on the southern side of Wilson Street, Darlington, west of Codrington Street, between Monday 13 May 2019 and Friday 19 May 2019, to provide a safe drop-off zone for taxis and hire cars during the 2019 Mercedes-Benz Fashion Week Australia.

Comments

Vigilant Group has requested the provision of a temporary “No Parking 8.30am-8.30pm” restriction, adjacent to Carriageworks, in Wilson Street, Darlington during the 2019 Mercedes-Benz Fashion Week Australia. This temporary restriction will provide a drop-off zone, 12 angle car spaces in length, for taxis and hire cars.

The kerb space on the southern side of Wilson Street, west of Codrington Street, is currently signposted as “60° Angle Parking, Rear to Kerb, Vehicles Under 6m Only”.

The proposal has been amended from previous years to provide the set-down area to the west of Codrington Street to reduce the number of taxis and hire cars completing U-turns in the street to access the drop-off area. As with previous years, the proposal allows for the temporary removal of 12 car parking spaces in total

The temporary restriction will be used for drop-off only. No taxi ranking will be permitted. The picking-up of passengers by taxis and hire cars will occur within the Carriageworks site. Vigilant Group will provide traffic control and encourage visitors to attend the event using public transport.

Consultation

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders at least seven days prior to the installation of the temporary signage.

Financial

All costs associated with the temporary signposting will be borne by the Applicant.
