

Item 14.**Road Works – Temporary Road Closure – Wilson Street, Newtown****TRIM Container No.: 2019/099520****Recommendations**

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the following temporary road closures in Newtown:

- Wilson Street, between Bucknell Street and Brocks Lane, from Saturday 31 August 2019 to Monday 23 September 2019;
- Westbound travel lanes in Wilson Street, between Burren and Queen Streets, from Thursday 1 August 2019 to Friday 7 February 2020; and
- Eastbound travel lanes in Wilson Street, between Queen and Golden Grove Streets, from Thursday 1 August 2019 to Friday 7 February 2020.

Subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as mentioned in Schedule B of this agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must comply with any other conditions imposed by City's Construction Regulation Unit.
- (C) The Applicant has indicated Monday 2 September 2019 to Tuesday 8 October 2019 as contingency dates for the closure of Wilson Street, between Bucknell Street and Brocks Lane.
- (D) The Applicant has indicated Thursday 15 August 2019 to Friday 6 March 2019 as contingency dates for the one-way closures of Wilson Street, between Burren Street and Golden Grove Streets.
- (E) The Applicant must contact the Newtown PAC to discuss deployment of user pay police for the road closure.
- (F) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed closure and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.

Background

The City of Sydney has applied for the temporary road closures in Newtown for the construction of the Wilson and Burren Streets Cycleway.

Comments

The proposed temporary road closures in Wilson Street are required to enable construction of the Wilson and Burren Streets Cycleway. A full width closure is proposed in the narrow section of Wilson Street. However, in the wider sections of Wilson Street, half-road closures are proposed (with one-way diversions) to minimise impact on traffic. The closures will happen concurrently, but for different durations.

The Applicant has provided a site-specific Traffic Control Plan with detour routes that includes details of barricades, signs, flagmen and other traffic devices to implement the proposed road closure.

There are currently no other approved temporary road closures proposed to take place on the same day in this area.

The temporary road closure will not affect any other properties, as local access will be provided at all times and alternative access routes are available nearby for through traffic.

A Traffic Management Plan (TMP) for the temporary road closure was approved by Roads and Maritime Services (RMS).

Consultation

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders as stipulated in Schedule B.

Financial

All costs associated with the proposed closure will be borne by Council.
