

**Item 15.****Road Works - Temporary Road Closure - Burton Street, Darlinghurst**

**Recommendations**

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the temporary road closure of the Burton Street viaduct, Darlinghurst, between Liverpool and West Streets (two lanes), for six months, subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as mentioned in Schedule B of this agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must comply with any other conditions imposed by City's Construction Regulation Unit.
- (C) The Applicant must contact the Kings Cross Police to discuss deployment of user pay police for the road closure.
- (D) The Applicant is to obtain a Road Occupancy Licence from the Transport Management Centre prior to commencement of works.
- (E) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed closure and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.
- (F) Access on the viaduct is to be maintained at all times for Sydney Buses and emergency vehicles.

## Background

Haslin Construction Pty Ltd has applied for the temporary road closure of the Burton Street viaduct, Darlinghurst, between Liverpool and West Streets (two lanes), for six months. Access on the viaduct is to be maintained at all times for Sydney Buses and emergency vehicles.

## Comments

The proposed temporary road closure of the Burton Street viaduct is required to carry out the following works:

- Construct a wider footway attached to the bridge;
- Upgrade safety barriers to current standards;
- Repair the viaduct arch bridges over Boundary Street and Barcom Avenue;
- Construct a new road deck and drainage network for the viaduct;
- Widen the footpath under the viaduct at Boundary Street to improve pedestrian access; and
- Upgrade lighting and improved signage.

The applicant has provided a site-specific Traffic Management Plan that includes details of barricades, signs, flagmen and other traffic devices to implement the proposed road closure and detour.

The temporary road closure will not affect any other properties, as local access will be provided at all times and alternative access routes are available nearby.

A Traffic Management Plan (TMP) for the temporary road closure has been approved by Roads and Maritime Services (RMS).

## Consultation

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders as stipulated in Schedule B.

The community have been updated about the works since April 2016 via community updates, online webpage and signage.

Notification letters have been sent out to inform the community about the proposal and temporary road closure dates.

City staff have consulted Kings Cross Police, Roads and Maritime Services (RMS), Sydney Buses and Woollahra Municipal Council who raise no objection to the proposed temporary road closure.
