Background

A resident of Norton Street, Glebe, has requested the removal of parking on the western side of the street, between Broughton Street and Broughton Lane, to improve vehicular access through the street.

Comments

Norton Street, between Broughton Street and Broughton Lane, is two-way and approximately 5.8 metres wide with unrestricted parking on the western side of the street and 2P permit parking on the eastern side.

On-site inspection shows that it is suitable to allocate the unrestricted parking on the western side of the street as “No Parking” in order to maintain vehicular access.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 69 letters sent out with no response supporting the proposal and one response opposing the proposal due to the loss of parking.
