3.7 Special event clearways

3.7.1 Towing Compounds

Towing Compounds were identified and implemented in 2017 when full course SEC were introduced. Full course SEC will continue in 2019.

In the event that vehicles remain parked on the course in SEC, the following Towing Compounds have been identified and to be used. This table outlines the management of the compounds.

From 0100 the towing operation will commence, TMC are managing the towing operation. The priority is to use the identified towing compound areas below first, then drop vehicles into available parking spaces off the course. At 0700 the last of the towing to commence, with towing vehicles off course by 0730.

Any vehicles remaining in the SEC, will be bollarded by the event traffic management supplier and a fine issued by NSW Police.

3.8 Road closures

Road closure infrastructure will be put into place by Who Dares and Coates in consultation with Police and TMC. Road closures will be maintained by Police, Traffic Controllers with assistance from volunteer marshals. Course marshals will monitor intersections only, not directly interacting with traffic, and will contact Police or traffic controller if vehicles violate the traffic infrastructure in place. All intersections will have an accredited traffic controller or Police member on point or within line of sight.

In the event that any course marshals do not arrive on site by the required time, a 'course filler' bus and additional marshals are arranged. This vehicle is on standby to work under direction from USM Events GCC rep when gaps are determined. See details below.

Darlinghurst Rd and Victoria St will remain open throughout the event to allow access in and out of the Kings Cross precinct.

Roads will be progressively re-opened by the Transport Management Centre (TMC) and Police after cleaning. Road closures affect both directions unless stated otherwise. The following road closures will also be in place:

2019 Updates

Road Closure Times

1. 11:30am Advertised reopening time of College St.

Due to the changing environment, and infrastructure required to mitigate risk, College Street has proven difficult to reopen at the existing advertised time of 11am.

Sydney Coordination Office has approved the advertised reopening of the following streets to be 11:30am, on the condition that operational planning is developed to reopen roads by 11:00am.

You will note the TCPs for these streets are planned for 11am reopening with contingency approval for 11:30am if required.

The road reopening plans will remain the same as 2018 working towards an 11am reopening but the public will be advised 11:30am to mitigate any negative reactions to a late reopening.

Streets affected are:

- College Street, between Liverpool Street and Prince Albert Road
- Macquarie Street, between Hunter Street and Prince Albert Road
- Prince Albert Road, between College Street and St Marys Road
- St James Road, between Elizabeth Street and Macquarie Street
- Stanley Street, between College Street and College Lane
- Francis Street, between College Street and College Lane

In 2018 the closure of William Street, from Riley St to Neild Ave, was brought forward from 7am to 6am with crossovers remaining open until 7.30am. This closure time will be continued in 2019.

Special Event Clearways

In 2017 Special Event Clearways were introduced along the whole length of the course. This will remain the same in 2019. This was not a new change for City of Sydney roads.

This was successfully implemented last year with minimal increase to cars being towed from previous years.
