3 Concept Plan

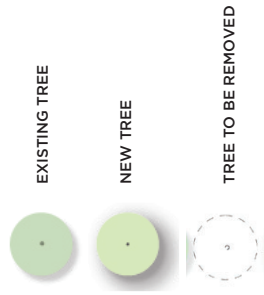
The concept design for Beaconsfield Park aims to build on the existing structure of the park. The playground and BBQ and picnic area frames the existing turf square and new paths extend the straight edge paths that frame the park.

New paths and walkway access at either end of the park increase accessibility and provide paths with good sight lines across the park.

A line of trees with BBQ and picnic tables frame the turf area and provide a social edge at the entry of the playground.

The playground is framed by paths and a series of sitting walls and planter beds that reduce the impact of the fencing. The play elements are shaded by a structure that provides planted arbour and dappled shade until the planting grows.
