**Final Concept Plan**

### 3 Concept Plan

The concept design for Daniel Dawson Reserve aims to frame the park in a generous band of planting and clear structure of paths and seating.

The playground located on the steepest slope of the park, is framed by a planted edge and a grove of new deciduous trees. The play space makes use of the slope for climbing and exploration as well as a large slide. The lower flat area of the park provides for swings, climbing structures and other play elements, and is framed by sitting walls and a diverse and textural planting palette, that provide character to the playground and also conceal the playground fencing.

The playground is in one of the more shady areas of the park, underneath large existing trees, maximising existing shade and minimising the need for large shade structures.
