Advice

Background

The development at 72-82 Mary Street, Surry Hills has removed a redundant driveway in Mary Street and has reinstated kerb, gutter and footpath, allowing on-street parking to be introduced. To do this, the existing "No Parking" signs adjacent to this development needs to be reallocated.

Comments

The kerb space on the eastern side of Mary Street, Surry Hills between Albion Way and Belmore Lane, is currently signposted as "No Parking".

The "No Parking" was originally installed to clarify the restriction across a driveway to 72-82 Mary Street. This driveway has since been removed, and kerb, gutter and footpath reinstated and as such, the "No Parking" restriction is no longer required.

The City proposes to replace the "No Parking" with "1/2P Ticket 8am-6pm Mon-Fri" and "4P Ticket 6-10pm Mon-Fri, 8am-10pm Sat-Sun & Public Holidays" to improve access to on-street parking for businesses in the area, consolidate parking restrictions in the area, and improve compliance for all road users.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 85 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
