Background

City West Housing has requested consideration of a temporary loading zone in Wentworth Street, Glebe, to assist tenants moving into the new affordable housing development at 1-5 Wentworth Street.

Comments

Parking on the southern side of Wentworth Street, between Bay and Stirling Streets, is a mixture of 2P permit parking and Works Zone.

The affordable housing development at 1-5 Wentworth Street is scheduled for completion in October 2019.

To assist tenants moving into the apartments, it is proposed to temporarily reallocate a section of the Works Zone as “Loading Zone 8am-6pm Mon-Fri” for a period of up to eight weeks.

The temporary Loading Zone will be changed to 2P permit parking once tenants have moved in and the Loading Zone is no longer required.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 215 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

Financial

All costs associated with the parking change will be borne by City West Housing.
