**Advice**

**Background**

On 20 June 2019, the Committee endorsed a proposal to widen the footpath on the southern side of Foveaux Street, Surry Hills from Elizabeth to Terry Streets, to improve pedestrian safety in the area. This will require the existing mailboxes to be relocated to just north of Terry Street.

### **Comments**

The kerb space on the southern side of Foveaux Street, east of Terry Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as “No Parking” for pick-up and set-down purposes.

To ensure unobstructed access to the new post box locations at all times, it is proposed to reallocate the adjacent kerb space as “Mail Zone”. A section of the existing “No Parking” will still be retained.

### **Consultation**

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 96 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
