Background

The City has received requests for traffic calming measures in Carillon Avenue, Camperdown, on approach to the marked pedestrian crossing just west of Western Avenue.

Comments

Carillon Avenue is a major east-west link and provides a connection from Missenden Road to City Road. There is an existing marked pedestrian crossing in Carillon Avenue located just west of the Western Avenue, which is the entrance into Sydney University, and adjacent Newtown North Public School and several child care centres.

Site observations showed that vehicles travelling along Carillon Avenue are not slowing down on approach to the crossing and are failing to give-way for pedestrians.

To address this, the City proposes to install a speed cushion on either side of the existing marked pedestrian crossing to slow down vehicles and provide more warning and time to stop to give way to pedestrians.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 148 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

Financial

Appropriate funding for the proposal will be secured once greater certainty on the construction timeline is reached.
