**Background**

The Appliance and Limb Centre Pty Ltd, originally located in Cope Street, has now been relocated to a new location so that the existing parking spaces reserved for people with disabilities, are no longer required. It is proposed to change this kerb space to “2P 8am-8pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area 41”.

## **Comments**

The kerb space on the western side of Cope Street, south of Turner Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "P Disability 7am-5pm Mon-Fri". It is proposed to reallocate this kerb space to permit parking as per the adjacent kerb space in the street.

The proposed changes would limit any vehicle which does not have a permit to two hours of parking from 8am-8pm Monday to Friday where the signs are installed.

Residents with an Area 41 parking permit will be exempt from the two-hour time limit.

A two-hour parking limit is preferred for streets in the inner residential areas as it better balances the long-stay parking needs of permit holders with the needs of all households to use parking for visitors, family, carers and tradespeople.
