Background

A resident has requested consideration to remove parking opposite their driveway in Eglington Lane to gain access into their garages.

Comments

The kerb space on the southern side of Eglinton Lane, between Edward Lane and Edward Street, is currently signposted as "2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area G"

Road Rules 2014 prohibits drivers from parking at any time across a driveway or in any other way which blocks access to a driveway. In narrow streets like Eglinton Lane, cars parking opposite driveways obstruct or prevent vehicles from entering or exiting garages. Section 6 of the Roads Act 1993 gives land owners a right of vehicle access between their land and the public road.

Site inspection shows that parking opposite driveways in Eglinton Lane need to be remove in order to provide vehicular access to the property.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 54 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
