Background

Place Management NSW (PMNSW) has requested consideration of updating two metered parking spaces on the eastern side of Quay St Haymarket into a multipurpose loading and metered parking zone during specific times including weekends.

PMNSW believes that the proposed change will increase parking options for motorists delivering goods and services to Haymarket therefore improving customer experience.

Comments

The two parking spaces on the eastern side of Quay Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as 2P and No Parking other times.

Usage monitoring of the Quay Street area has shown a high demand for parking spaces for the general public and counterbalanced by legitimate use for business deliveries in the area.

It is proposed to convert the two parking spaces indicated on the attached map to meter parking with time limit, fees, Loading Zone and “metre” parking scheme arrangements.

New street signage will be installed, managed and maintained by PMNSW in accordance with the relevant RMS guidelines.

Consultation

In developing this initiative, PMNSW has reviewed the areas use and established there is a clear need for parking for stakeholders therefore giving up the existing time restricted use and opening the spaces up for public use. Consulted Duncan Solutions, PMNSW and CBRE.

Financial

All costs associated with the parking changes, signage replacement will be borne by PMNSW.
