## **Background**

A resident has requested consideration for a disability parking space on the western side of Bay Street, Glebe, between Elger and Queen Streets.

#### Comments

Bay Street, between Elger and Queen Streets, is a two-way street that is approximately 12.6 metres wide with 3.5 metre wide footpaths and 3.3 metre wide parking lanes on both sides of the street. The road and footway grades adjacent to the proposed space is relatively flat.

The kerb space on the western side of Bay Street, where the parking change is proposed, is unrestricted for parking and adjacent to a driveway.

The Australian Standard for on-street disability parking (AS 2890.5 – 1993) requires spaces to be 5.5 metres long and 3.2 metres wide for an end space.

On-site inspection shows that the proposed location meets the requirements of the Australian Standard.

The City's Inclusive and Accessibility Public Domain Guidelines notes that not every designated on-street mobility parking space provided for residential use needs to comply with the requirements of the Australian Standard.

### Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 272 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
