Background

A resident has advised that the existing "Disability Parking Only" space in Ashmore Street, Erskineville is no long required and can be removed.

Comments

The kerb space on the southern side of Ashmore Street, Erskineville, east of Binning Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "Disability Parking Only".

In response to the disability parking space no longer being required, it is proposed to reallocate this kerb space to "2P 8am-6pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area 40". The proposal would be consistent with the adjacent on-street parking restrictions in Ashmore Street.

The proposed parking changes would limit any vehicle which does not have an Area 40 parking permit to two hours of parking from 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, where the signs are installed.

Residents with an Area 40 parking permit will be exempt from the two-hour time limit.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 146 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
