Background

A resident has requested consideration to remove parking opposite their driveway in Charlton Way, Glebe, to gain access into their garages.

Comments

The kerb space on the eastern side of Charlton Way, north of Forsyth Street where the parking change is proposed, is currently unrestricted.

The NSW Roads Act and Road Rules gives land owners a right to access between their land and the public road, and prohibits drivers from parking in a way which blocks access to a driveway. In narrow streets like Charlton Way, residents cannot access their garages when cars are parked opposite their driveway.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 181 letters sent out with no responses supporting the proposal and two responses opposing the proposal due to the loss of parking.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
