Background

The Little Albion Boutique Hotel at 21 Little Albion Street, Surry Hills has requested consideration of 'No Parking' to allow for drop-off and pick-up in front of the hotel.

Comments

The kerb space on the northern side of Little Albion Street, Surry Hills opposite the Hotel near Wade Place, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as 'No Stopping'.

Little Albion Street is one-way eastbound with parking only permitted on the northern side of the street. As the street is very narrow and carries low traffic volumes, it is considered safe to provide a drop-off zone on the opposite side of the street from the hotel. The current 'No Stopping' restriction is excessive and can be reduced without impact to traffic or resident parking conditions. Note: Ausgrid permanently occupies Wade Place as part of the adjacent substation building and it is therefore closed to all vehicles and pedestrians.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a 'No Parking' restriction to provide a pick-up and drop-off area.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 105 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
