- (A) On western side, between the points 10 metres and 89 metres (13 car spaces), as "No Parking 7am-10am Wed Only" south of Boronia Street; and
- (B) On eastern side, between the points 10 metres and 89 metres (13 car spaces), as "No Parking" south of Boronia Street.

Background

A resident of Young Street, Redfern has requested consideration of "No Parking" in Young Lane to improve waste vehicle access to the laneway.

Comments

The kerb space in Young Lane, Redfern between Boronia and Telopea Streets, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

The road width in Young Lane is approximately 4.4 metres. When cars are parked in the unrestricted spaces, it leaves only 2.3 metres for waste vehicles to access through the laneway. Therefore, it is proposed to provide "No Parking 7am-10am Wed Only" restrictions on the western side of Young Lane, during waste collection periods. This will ensure that waste vehicles can operate in a safe and efficient manner on collection days. The eastern side of the lane will also need to be signposted as "No Parking" as the lane is not wide enough for parking on both sides.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 159 letters sent out with three responses supporting the proposal and four responses opposing the proposal due to the loss of on-street parking. However, the restrictions only apply on one day in the week and residents can still parking in the lane after 10am on that day.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
