Background

Substation East Pty Ltd, a café business located in Rothchild Avenue, Rosebery near Harcourt Parade, has requested consideration of short-term parking in front of their property to increase turnover and availability of parking.

Comments

The kerb space on the western side of Rothschild Avenue, Rosebery between Harcourt Parade and Hayes Road, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

The customers of the Café business can not find parking space nearby because the kerb space is fully occupied at all times. On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide short-term parking to increase parking turnover and space availability for nearby stakeholders especially on weekdays. The kerb space will be retained unrestricted on weekends.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 84 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
