A holistic review of the HFS should be undertaken, to retain measures to support ongoing maintenance of heritage buildings, but also to regulate the costs to industry.	The City is aware of the issues raised in the submission, which are much broader than the proposal to extend the operation of the alternative scheme for Development Applications lodged after 1 January 2021. The City has previously made changes to create additional HFS including extending the scope to government buildings and allow buildings to be re-awarded HFS after 25 years. The City will continue to monitor and review the heritage floor space scheme as needed to ensure it remains an incentive for conservation without resulting in onerous costs for development.
