Background

Transport for NSW's CBD and South East Light Rail (CSELR) project from Circular Quay to Kingsford and Randwick via Surry Hills started construction on 25 October 2015.

Work has now completed on the CSELR with changes made to the road network along and next to the light rail corridor such as road closures, direction of traffic flow, line marking and kerbside parking changes.

Comments

A trial road closure has commenced on Devonshire Street from Chalmers Street to Elizabeth Street to pedestrianise the area. The closure includes the closure of Chalmers Lane at Devonshire Street. Parking within the closure will not be permitted.

Consultation

The CSELR Environmental Impact Statement and further consultation during light rail construction has met requirements to liaise with community on traffic and parking change.

Financial

Transport for NSW has funded signposting as part of the CSELR project.
