Background

A resident of Barcom Avenue has requested consideration to remove parking in between two driveways to improve driveway access.

Comments

The kerb space on the eastern side of Barcom Avenue, between the driveways of BMW Sydney and Rushcutters Self Storage, is currently unrestricted and about 3.2 metres long.

The Australian Standard for on-street parking (AS 2890.5:2020) requires parallel parking spaces to be a minimum of 5.4 metres for end spaces where drivers can enter or leave the space directly.

Section 198 of the Road Rules 2014 prohibits drivers from stopping on or across a driveway.

On-site inspection shows that the kerb space in between the two driveways does not fit a standard car. To improve driveway access, it is proposed to signpost the two driveways and kerb space in between as "No Parking".

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 50 letters sent out with no responses supporting the proposal and two responses opposing the proposal due to loss of parking.
