Background

The City has received a request to replace the existing "No Parking Police Vehicles Excepted" restriction in Renwick Street, Redfern and to provide more parking for residents and businesses in the area. NSW Police have advised that the restriction is no longer required.

Comments

The kerb space on the eastern side of Renwick Street, Redfern between Wells and James Streets, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "No Parking Police Vehicles Excepted".

Given that the Police parking in this location is no longer required, by the Police, on-site inspections shows that it could be removed and replaced with unrestricted parking as per the adjacent kerb pace. This will provide two more parking spaces in the area for nearby stakeholders.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 131 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
