

Item 13.**Road Works - Temporary Road Closure - Macdonald Street, Erskineville**

Recommendations

It is recommended that the Committee endorse the temporary road closures between 18 September 2021 to 28 February 2022 inclusive, on the following streets in Erskineville:

- Macdonald Street, between Bridge and Hadfields Streets;
- Zenith Street, between Metters and MacDonald Streets;
- Pearl Street, between Metters and Macdonald Streets;
- Eve Street, between MacDonald Street and Brightwell Lane; and
- Goddard Street, south of Macdonald Street.

subject to the following conditions:

- (A) The Applicant must comply with the temporary road closure conditions as mentioned Schedule B of this agenda.
- (B) The Applicant must comply with any other conditions imposed by City's Construction Regulation Unit.
- (C) The Applicant must contact the South Sydney PAC to discuss deployment of user pay police for the road closures.
- (D) The Applicant is to obtain a Road Occupancy Licence from the Transport Management Centre prior to commencement of works.
- (E) The Applicant must provide a telephone number of the supervisor responsible for the proposed closure and include contact details in the notification letters to be distributed to affected stakeholders.

Background

On 15 October 2020, the Committee endorsed the road closures around Macdonald Street, Erskineville between Monday 26 October 2020 and 17 September 2021. Ward Civil & Environmental Engineering Pty Ltd has applied to extend the period of the closures to 28 February 2022 to allow for the completion of the works which have been delayed due to unexpected latent conditions in the ground.

Comments

The proposed temporary road closures are required to enable the installation of major trunk drainage together with services relocations and removal of overhead power lines and the provision of underground power lines in Goddard Street, Erskineville.

In December 2019, the Committee endorsed a series of streetscape changes in Macdonald Street, including a separated cycleway, three raised pedestrian crossings and continuous footpath treatments across Goddard and Eve Streets just south of Macdonald Street. These works would be constructed as part of the road works.

The Applicant has provided a site-specific Traffic Control Plan to ensure that the closures can be implemented safely without preventing access for road users to properties and includes details of barricades, signs, flagmen and other traffic devices to implement the proposed road closures. Outside of work hours, traffic will be managed by temporary traffic signals.

The temporary road closures will not affect any other properties, as local access will be provided at all times and alternative access routes are available nearby.

A Traffic Management Plan (TMP) for the temporary road closure was approved by Transport for NSW (TFNSW).

Consultation

The Applicant will be required to notify affected stakeholders as stipulated in Schedule B.

Financial

All costs associated with the proposed closures will be borne by the applicant.
