Background

The development of 5 Ralph Street, Alexandria (D/2020/562) requires that the Applicant submits a signage plan for kerbside parking arrangements along the site's frontage in Ralph Street to be referred to the Local Pedestrians, Cycling and Traffic Calming Committee.

Comments

The City has approved the redevelopment of 5 Ralph Street, Alexandria.

The kerb space on the eastern side of Ralph Street, south of Beaconsfield Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

It is proposed to install parking restrictions to reflect the change in adjacent land use. As such, it is proposed to install "2P 8am-8pm" along the frontage of the redevelopment site in Ralph Street. The hours of restricted parking are consistent with those in nearby streets.

A two-hour parking limit is preferred for streets in the inner residential areas as it better balances the long-stay parking needs of permit holders with the needs of all households to use parking for visitors, family, carers and tradespeople.

Consultation

The Applicant must notify adjacent properties at least seven days prior to the implementation.

Financial

All costs associated with the parking changes will be borne by the applicant.
