Background

A resident of William Street, Redfern has requested the extension to the existing "No Stopping" in front of their house to enable them to access their front gate.

Comments

The kerb space on the western side of William Street, Redfern between Short and Wells Streets, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "2P 8am-8pm Mon-Fri Permit Holders Excepted Area 41".

On-site inspection shows there is a need to extend the existing "No Stopping" restriction to allow access to the property.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 134 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
