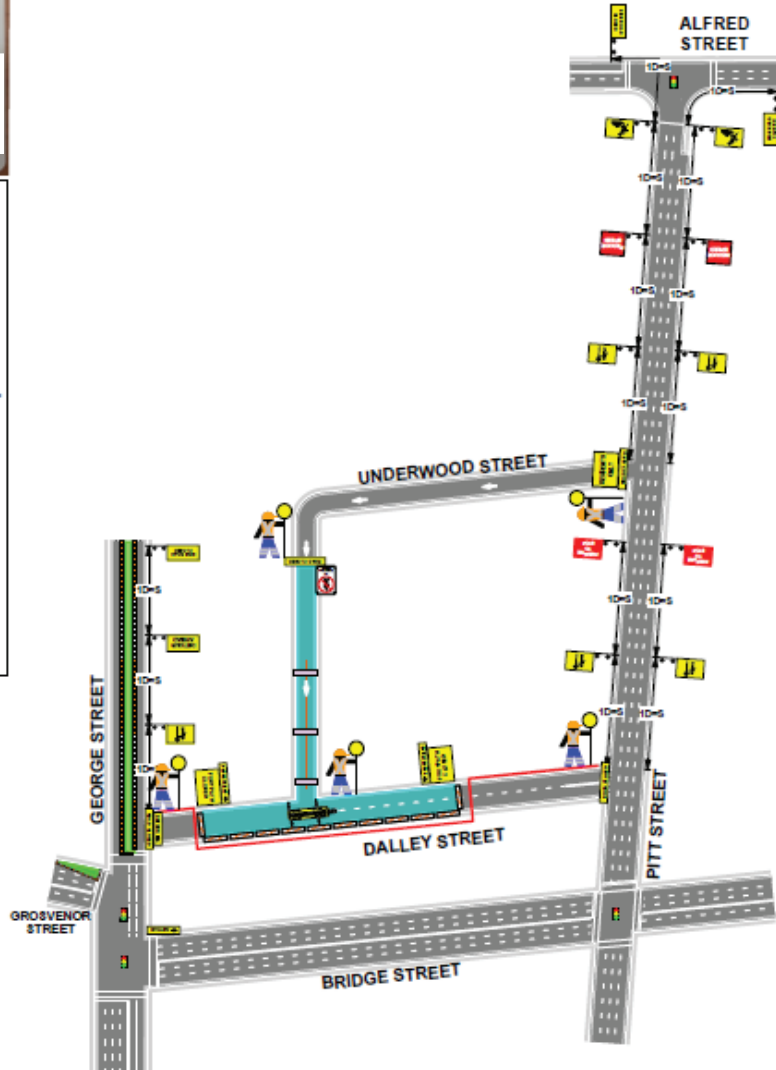

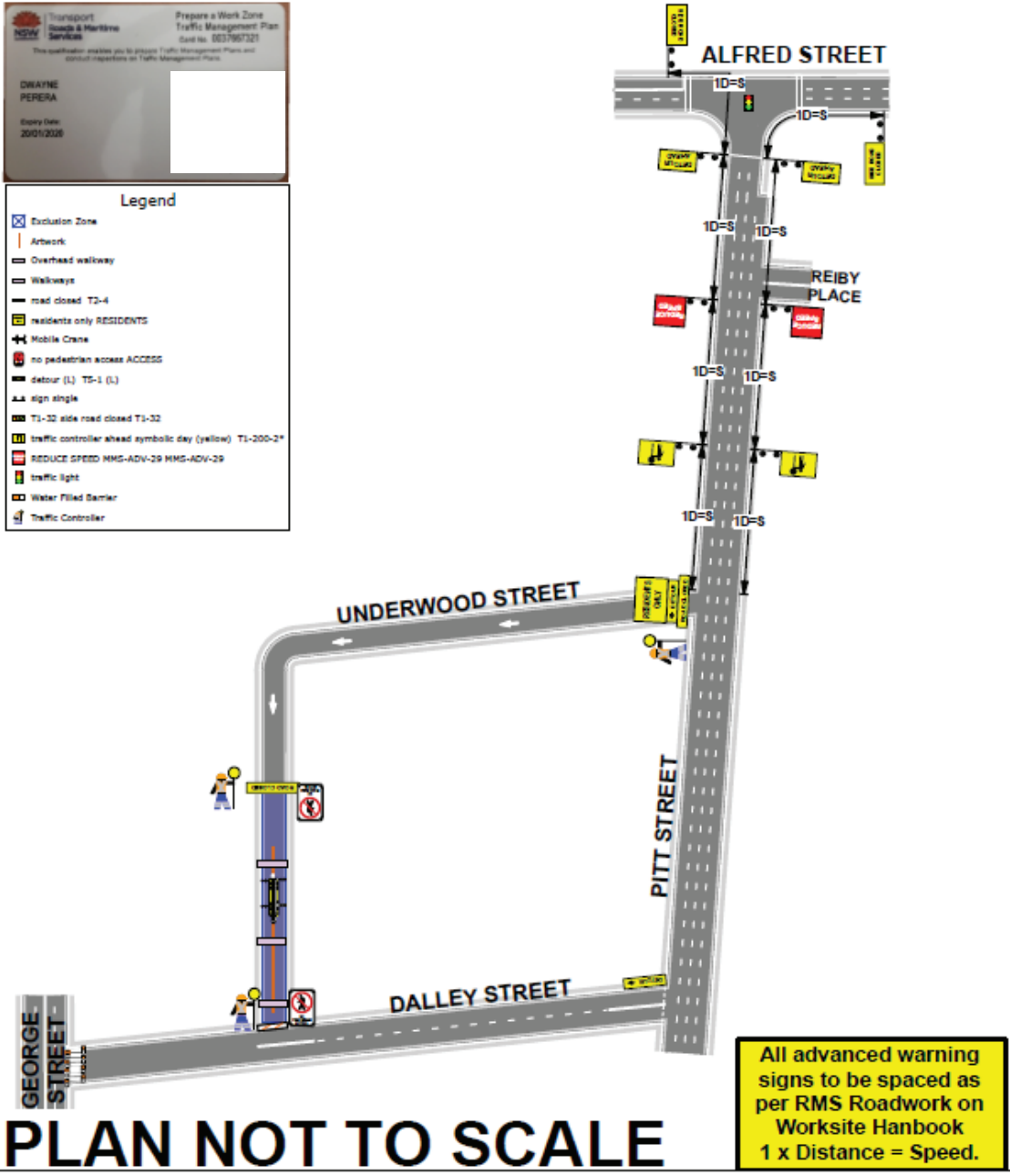

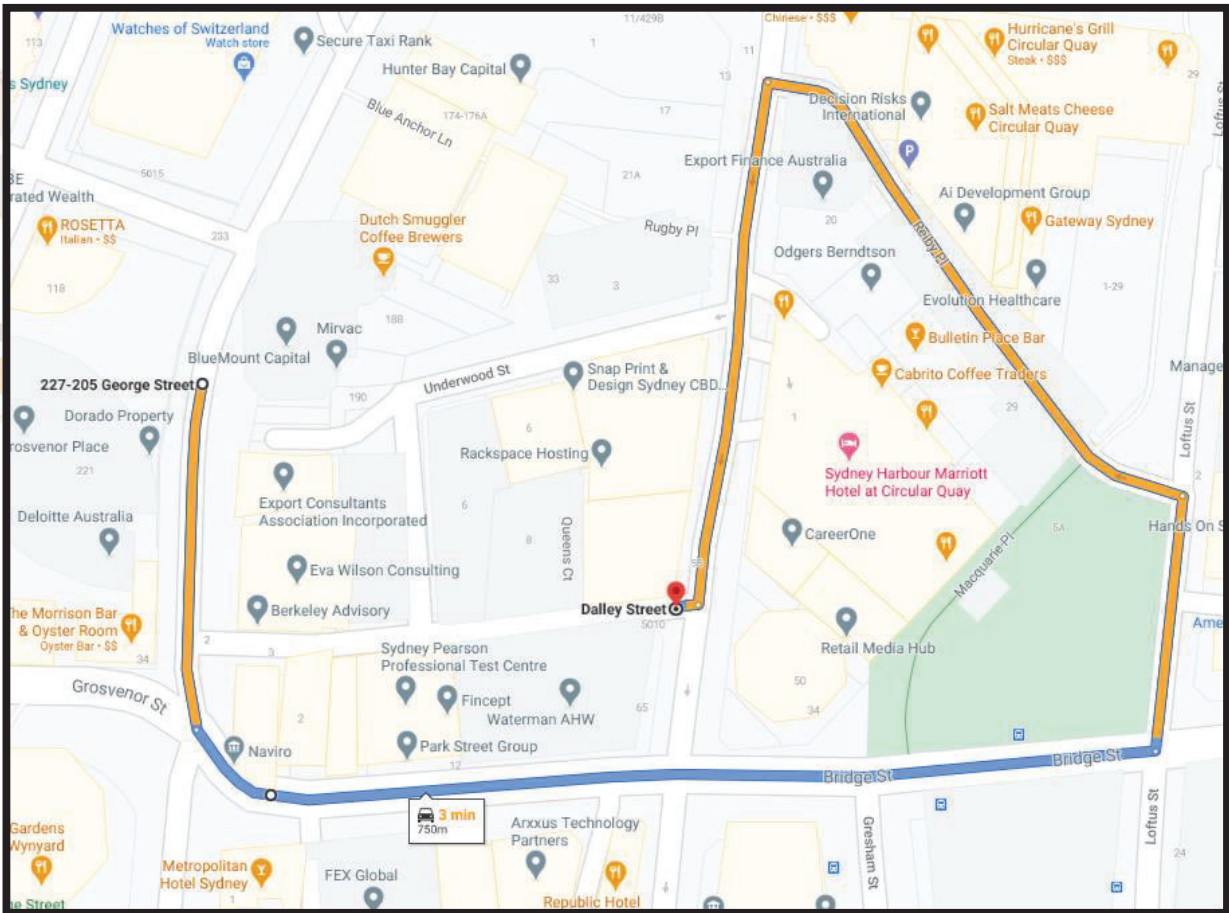

# DETOUR ROUTE FOR DALLEY & UNDERWOOD STREET ACCESS

<b>227-205 George St</b> Sydney NSW 2000	
↑ Head south on George St towards Dalley St 95 m	↶ Turn left onto Reiby Pl 170 m
↶ George St turns slightly left and becomes Bridge St 270 m	↶ Turn left onto Pitt St 140 m
↶ Turn left onto Loftus St 70 m	↷ Turn right onto Dalley St 6 m
<b>Dalley St</b> Sydney NSW 2000	



Appropriate detour signs are to be placed out to assist with vehicles navigating this detour.
