Background

A resident of Hadfields Street has requested consideration of extending the existing "No Stopping" restriction in Coulson Street to improve safety and sight distance for vehicles turning right into Coulson Street from Hadfields Street.

Comments

The kerb space on the northern side of Coulson Street, Erskineville between Hadfields and Eve Streets, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

On-site inspection shows that when vehicles make right turn from Hadfields Street into Coulson Street, sight distance is obstructed by parked vehicles, therefore, it is proposed to extend the existing "No Stopping" restriction to improve safety and sight distance.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 805 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
