#### **Background**

At the meeting of the Corporate, Finance, Properties and Tenders Committee on 4 April 2022, further information was sought on how the 10 Sustainable Sydney 2030-2050 Continuing the Vision Project Ideas apply across the Local Government Area.

# Ten project ideas are proposed to bring life to Sustainable Sydney 2030-2050 Continuing the Vision

A majority of project ideas extend beyond the city centre and across the entire Local Government Area (LGA).

<u>Project Idea 1 – Yananurala (Harbour Walk)</u> is part of the broader Eora Journey recognition in the public domain program which includes projects in Redfern, and across the entire Local Government Area.

<u>Project Idea 3 – The Green City</u> includes ideas for green avenues such as Broadway and Botany Road, supporting residents to green neighbourhood laneways and ideas for sharing open space at Moore Park.

<u>Project Idea 5 – The Water City</u> includes implementing Local Government Area wide water recycling, water efficiency and water sensitive urban dense projects.

<u>Project Idea 6 – Connecting Green Square</u> covers surface transport connecting Green Square to the city centre.

<u>Project Idea 7 - Metro as Catalyst</u> covers public transport to support the residents of Green Square precinct.

<u>Project Idea 8 – Building on Housing for all</u> covers affordable and social housing across the Local Government Area.

<u>Project Idea 9 – Making space for Culture</u> covers creating space for cultural production and supporting existing cultural precincts across the Local Government Area.

<u>Project Idea 10 – Reimaging Our Community Assets</u> covers the City's community assets across the Local Government Area.
