Background

The Downing Centre Local and District Court has requested consideration for "No Parking" restrictions between 6am and 3pm Monday to Friday next to the building's driveway to improve access for the Centre's operational vehicles.

Comments

The kerb space on the eastern side of Castlereagh Street, Sydney between Liverpool and Goulburn Streets, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "Loading Zone Ticket 6am-3pm Mon-Fri 6am-10am Sat", "4P Ticket 8pm-Midnight Mon-Fri 10am-10pm Sat 8am-10pm Sun & Public Holidays" and "No Stopping 3pm-8pm Mon-Fri".

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide "No Parking" restriction next to the driveway to The Downing Centre Local and District Court during business hours on weekdays to improve access for the Centre's operational vehicles.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 301 letters sent out with one response supporting and three responses opposing the proposal.

The response supporting the proposal noted that the proposed parking changes will improve access for the Centre's operational vehicles.

The responses objecting to the proposal were concern about the loss of loading zone spaces in Castlereagh Street.

The proposal retains four loading zone spaces to assist businesses and residents with their deliveries and loading requirements.
