Background

A resident of Hutchinson Walk, Zetland has requested consideration of a short section "No Parking" in the street to increase sight distance and improve safety for wheelchair users.

Comments

The kerb space on the southern side of Hutchinson Walk, Zetland, between Gadigal Avenue and George Julius Avenue, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

Given the alignment of the street on the approach to Gadigal Avenue, pedestrians can't see on-coming traffic when stepping out to cross the intersection and it is especially difficult for local residents who are wheel chair bound or others with prams.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a "No Parking" restriction to increase sight distance and improve safety.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 872 letters sent out with 5 responses supporting the proposal and no responses opposing the proposal.

Financial

Funds are available in the current budget.
