Major Legal Issues - Quarter 3 2021/22

Council of the City of Sydney v Owners Corporation SP34626 and Combined Communications Network Pty Limited (9 – 13 O'Riordan Street, Alexandria)

The City has commenced proceedings in the Supreme Court of NSW requesting that the Court order a readjustment of the of the land owned by SP34626 in order for the City to compulsorily acquire the land in accordance with the *Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation) Act 1993 (NSW)*. The land is required to deliver the Green Square to Ashmore connector road, currently under construction. Council resolved to commence these proceedings by resolution dated 18 October 2021. The proceedings in the Supreme Court are required for the compulsory acquisition of part of a strata plan to proceed.
