Background

A resident of James Street, Redfern has requested consideration of "No Stopping" in their street as when vehicles are parked in the street, there is not enough room left for other vehicles to pass.

Comments

The kerb space on the northern side of James Street, Redfern between Little Young Lane and Young Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

The Street is only 3.7 metres wide and cars are parking on top of the kerb/footpath along the northern side of the street so that traffic can pass. However, the space is very narrow and parking on a footpath is contrary to the Road Rules.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a "No Stopping" restriction to improve vehicle access in the street.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 96 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
