Determinations Delegated by the Central Sydney Planning Committee to the City of Sydney

Summary

Background

1. On 24 June 2004, the Central Sydney Planning Committee (CSPC) delegated authority to the City of Sydney for the determination of development applications involving a variation to a development standard and costing less than \$50 million. A report to the CSPC on the applications determined under the delegation is required at a minimum of every six months. In accordance with the reporting requirements prescribed in the Planning Circular PS08-014 issued by the NSW Department of Planning and Environment, a quarterly report is being submitted to the CSPC.
2. Thirty-two (32) applications were approved where there has been a variation to a development standard during the period 1 October to 31 December 2017. Details of the applications are included in the table of Attachment A.
