# Background

A resident of Bijou Lane has requested consideration of "No Stopping" in Bijou Lane to improve access and safety in the laneway.

# Comments

The kerb space on the northern side of Bijou Lane, Haymarket, west of Quay Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "No Parking".

Bijou Lane is a two-way "No Through Road" that provides access to residential and commercial unit car parks. The laneway is approximately 5.2 metres wide. When a vehicle stops in the "No Parking" zone, it restricts vehicle access and impacts on road safety for all road users in the laneway.

On-site inspection shows there is a need to provide a "No Stopping" restriction to improve traffic safety in the laneway.

In a "No Stopping" zone, vehicles must not stop at any point on the road or kerb in the direction of the arrow, unless in an emergency.

### Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 223 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
