Background

Place Management NSW has requested consideration of extending and relocating the existing Loading Zone on the frontage of 157 George Street to improve clearance for vehicles using the adjacent turning circle and improve on-street loading access.

Comments

The kerb space on the western side of George Street, The Rocks between the driveway access to 157 George Street and Globe Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently signposted as "Loading Zone 7am-6pm".

To improve clearance for vehicles to use the adjacent turning circle and improve on-street loading access, it is proposed to relocate and extend the loading zones. The loading zones will operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to improve on-street parking access for vehicles to pick up and drop off passengers and goods.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 95 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
