Background

A resident of Phillip Street, Waterloo has requested consideration of "No Parking" at the rear of their property in Vescey Street to improve access to their garage.

Comments

The kerb space on the southern side of Vescey Street, Waterloo east of Union Street, where the changes are proposed, is currently unrestricted for parking.

Vescey Street is approximately 5.4 metres wide and provides rear-lane property access to houses fronting Phillip Street.

The NSW Road Rules 2014 prohibit drivers from parking at any time across a driveway, or in any other way which blocks access to a driveway. In narrow streets like Vescey Street, car parking opposite driveways obstruct or prevent vehicles from entering or exiting these driveways. Section 6 of the Roads Act 1993 gives adjoining land owners a right of vehicles access to the public road.

Consultation

The City consulted local residents and businesses in the area. There were 78 letters sent out with no responses supporting or opposing the proposal.
