Background

A resident of Redfern has requested the City extend the existing "No Stopping" restriction in Bourke Street north of the intersection with Thurlow Street to improve safety and drivers' sightline when turning into the intersection.

Comments

The eastern side of Bourke Street, north of Thurlow Street has a statutory 'No Stopping' restriction, however, it is only 5.5 metres from the intersection. The kerb space adjacent to the proposed changes is unrestricted for parking.

Under the NSW Road Rules 2014, a driver must not stop on a road within 10 metres from an intersection without traffic lights. Parking at intersections can obstruct driver vision, especially during right turn movements, and cause unsafe conditions for pedestrians crossing the road.

Therefore, the City is proposing to extend the current "No Stopping" restriction to 10 metres from the intersection of Thurlow Street. This will improve safety, drivers' sightline at the intersection and will be consistent with the NSW Road Rules 2014.
